



The Mob Museum

Opened in 2012 The Mob Museum is a worldclass destination in downtown Las Vegas. It's solely dedicated to the thrilling story of organized crime and law enforcement. It presents an exciting and authentic view of the Mob's impact on Las Vegas history.



The 41,000-square-foot museum features 16,000 square feet of exhibit space that spans three floors. It's located inside the former federal courthouse where the 1950-51 Kefauver Committee hearings were held.

True stories of Mob history are brought to life in a bold and contemporary style via engaging exhibits, high-tech theater presentations and more than 600 artifacts, the largest collection of Mob and related law enforcement memorabilia under one roof.

The Valley Of Fire

Located in the Mojave Desert approximately 58 miles Northeast of the Las Vegas Strip. Valley of Fire is the oldest Nevada State Park and was dedicated in 1935.

The 35,000 acre park is filled with the classic quintessential south-western desert scenery. You'll be able to hike through crazy rock formations with even crazier names like Arch Rock and Mouse's tank. And see ancient Native American Petroglyphs.

When planning your trip the best times to hike are early morning and late afternoon. Also keep an eye on the climate. Winters are mild with temperatures ranging from freezing to 75 degrees. Daily summer highs often exceed 100 degrees. Summer temperatures can vary significantly from day to night. Average annual rainfall is four inches, coming from light winter showers and summer thunderstorms.


